

PESTICIDE USE NEAR SCHOOLS

The California Department of Public Health found that pesticide use near schools was extremely high—more than 500,000 public school children attended schools within 1/4-mile of agricultural pesticide use.

Many of the chemicals applied near schools are of public health concern, including carcinogens, cholinesterase inhibitors, endocrine disruptors, and toxic air contaminants.

NEW RULES FOR PESTICIDES USE NEAR SCHOOLS


Within ¼ mile of schools, from 6 AM to 6 PM Monday through Friday, drift-prone pesticide applications will not be allowed.

Additionally, each year schools will receive a notice with a list of all the pesticides that growers within ¼ mile intend to apply for the next year.





THIS IS YOUR BRAIN ON CHLORPYRIFOS




CHLORPYRIFOS (KLOAR-PEER-UH-FAHS)

- Invented by Nazis as nerve gas
- Made by Dow Chemical as organophosphate pesticide
- Cheap and works on killing bugs
- 5-10 million pounds used annually in US; about 1 million pounds in California

CHLORPYRIFOS DRIFTS FOR MILES AND WEEKS AFTER APPLICATION



THE RESEARCH



+Columbia University, UC Davis, and UC Berkeley (CHAMACOS) have done main studies +Prenatal exposure to tiny amounts of chlorpyrifos over time is linked to higher incidences of

- nerve damage
- ADHD
- IQ loss
- Autism
- lung damage



POLICIES OF ENVIRONMENTAL RACISM

- From 1965 to 2000: no restrictions on chlorpyrifos
- 2000-2006: US EPA & CalEPA phased out chlorpyrifos use indoors and in residential areas but NOT for agricultural use
- 2014: US EPA, under court pressure, agrees to reexamine chlorpyrifos use in the fields
- 2016: CalEPA makes chlorpyrifos "restricted"
- November 2016: US EPA scientists found no safe uses under current conditions and recommended a nationwide chlorpyrifos ban

WILL CALIFORNIA PROTECT US FROM CHLORPYRIFOS?



- After public outcry, Attorney General Becerra joined lawsuit against Pruitt to ban
- California Senators endorsed bill to ban
- OEHHA designated it a reproductive toxin
- Hawaii banned it!
- Federal Appeals Court ordered it banned in US last August, but Trump Administration appealed



CALIFORNIA CHLORPYRIFOS BAN? NOT YET ...

- So far, California's Department of Pesticide Regulation has acted like Trump Admin.
- Ignored US EPA science and recommendations and Court Order
- Started yearslong process of further study
- "Interim mitigations": buffer zones 1/4mile, no planes

Suspend Use of Harmful Agricultural Pesticides

Dear California EPA Secretary Blumenfeld:

With the absence of leadership at the federal level, we expect the state of California to do what the nation is not willing to do—create an action plan to reduce and suspend use of harmful agricultural chemicals. In particular, California EPA must encourage the California Department of Pesticide Regulation to suspend use of all organophosphates and neonicotinoids. We also ask the agency to encourage DPR to do meaningful work on reducing and then suspending the use of the herbicide glyphosate. There can be no further delay in action.

Regulatory capture by industry has resulted in our environment being contaminated by vast quantities of agricultural chemicals. In fact, glyphosate is used by our own state Department of Transportation.
